BRACKETED KO's - Begin Every Day! Based on Average Points. **GOLD POINTS** for overall rankings within each bracket.
Super Chart - Allowed for top bracket of Bracketed Knockouts. **Mid Chart** - Allowed for flight Ax & A of Stratiflighted events only.

COMPACT KOs - teams limited to four members. **GOLD POINT EVENTS** in CAPITAL letters. **TIMES P.M.** except where indicated.

SIDE GAMES (CONTINUOUS PAIRS) SERIES - Players count the best two scores in an event for overalls. Player may change partners each session, but must play minimum of two sessions in an event to be eligible for Gold Points for that event.

Intermediate/Newcomer Pairs - Twice Daily Beginning Wednesday

Single session events twice Daily, 1 and 7 p.m.. Stratified 0-50, 50-200, 200-300. Prizes and/or trophies for overall winners.
